The certification status of all DBEs will be reviewed on any notical basis by DSMBR. The annual review will be conducted through examination of a sworn affidavit of continuing eligibility (Annual Update "No Change" Affidavit) submitted by the firm seeking continued certification as outlined in 49 CFR Part 26. Additionally, a DBE on-site review will be conducted by DSMBR every three years in conjunction with the DBE firm's submittal of the Annual Update Affidavit, as outlined in 49 CFR Part 26.

Prior to reaching your annual certification anniversary, you will be asked to submit the DBE Annual Update Affidavit, including support documentation. It is important, however, that during the course of your certification, you report in writing any change(s) in circumstances affecting size, disadvantaged status, ownership or control requirements of 49 CFR Part 26, or any material change in the information provided in your application for DBE certification, to DSMBR within 30 calendar days of such change. Failure to adhere to these requirements shall result in the decertification of your firm under the procedures of 49 CFR Part 26.

In addition, during the course of your certification you will be responsible for maintaining an accurate mailing address and business telephone number and keeping current the specific scopes of work (commodity codes) in which you, the disadvantaged owner(s), has the ability and expertise to manage and control the firm's operations and work. Any address changes, as well as additions and deletions to commodity codes, must be made by you in the City of Austin's Vendor Self-Service (VSS) System at www.ci.austin.tx.us/vss/Advantage.
